NOTICE

In accordance with Resolution No. 87-81 adopted by the Santa Maria City Council on June 16, 1987, and Resolution No. 97-31 adopted by the Santa Maria City Council on April 1, 1997, the rates for use of the City of Santa Maria Landfill will be increased effective July 1, 2001 as follows:

<u>Inert Material/Ton</u>	\$ 27.25 prorated for all loads
<u>Hard-to-Handle/Ton</u>	\$105.85 prorated for all loads

Large Truck	\$ 13.35 each

Refuse is accepted solely from the regional area which includes Northern Santa Barbara County (Orcutt North) and Southern San Luis Obispo County (Los Berros South).
