A Representative is Needed to Fill an All-America City Committee Vacancy

The City of Santa Maria is still seeking a representative to serve on the All-America City Committee. Applications will be accepted until 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 18, 2010. The appointment will be made at the City Council meeting of April 6, 2010.

All-America City Committee: (one appointment will be made to Low/Moderate Income segment category only) Members of this Committee evaluate the civic health and pride of the community through partnerships and creative approaches and ensure collaboration with the public and private sector in the spirit of the All-America City Program. The Committee meets on the third Monday of each month at 5:30 p.m. Members are nominated by individual Councilmembers, appointed by the Mayor, and confirmed by the City Council. The applicant will be appointed to serve an unexpired term ending in January 2011 and must represent the Low/Moderate Income segment of the community.

Unless a specific advisory body has a City residency requirement, it is the policy of the City Council to appoint, whenever possible, residents of the City to fill appointive positions on all City commissions, boards and committees.
