**Landfill Customers to Use Alternate Entrance during Gate Reconstruction**

Beginning on Monday, August 9<sup>th</sup>, customers coming to the Santa Maria Regional Landfill will be redirected to access the former entrance on East Main Street, while contractors make improvements to the main entrance at Philbric Road.

This temporary detour will last about two weeks and the landfill will be open as usual during regular business hours.

This \$122,000 project will widen the existing landfill gate at the intersection of East Main Street and Philbric Road, replace a storm drain pipe which runs across the entrance, and install other improvements to enhance the flow of traffic into and out of the landfill. Brough Construction, Inc., of Arroyo Grande will perform the work under contract with the City.

Customers will be redirected to the former landfill entrance about a half-mile west. City staff strongly recommends that drivers obey all detour signs, temporary construction traffic control signs, and flagmen.
