Take Reading to the Next Level with ebooks from the Santa Maria Public Library *Users have 24/7 access to titles compatible with popular e-reading devices*

The Santa Maria Public Library has expanded its download collection with the addition of eBooks at <http://blackgold.lib.overdrive.com>. From the comfort of home, card holders can browse the collection, check out, and download eBooks and more anytime, anywhere.

eBooks can be read on personal computers using free reader software called Adobe® Digital Editions, and also can be transferred to compatible e-reading devices.

“eBooks are growing in popularity and we are excited to offer this new format in addition to thousands of audio books and videos currently available,” City Librarian Jack Buchanan said.”

The Black Gold Cooperative Libraries opening collection features 200 titles including bestsellers such as *The Passage* by Justin Cronin, *Innocent* by Scott Turow, *One Day* by David Nicholls and *The Particular Sadness of Lemon Cake* by Aimee Bender.

To check out eBooks or audio books, users need a valid library card, computer, and Internet connection. Once downloaded, digital media can be enjoyed on a computer and transferred to popular devices such as MP3 players, iPods®, Smartphones, and more. eBooks can only be transferred to compatible eBook devices. At the end of the lending period, titles automatically expire and are returned to the collection. Users may return eBooks early.

The Santa Maria Public Library and the Black Gold Cooperative partner with OverDrive, Inc. (www.overdrive.com), a global leader in digital media services, to offer the download service.
