Residential Water Audits

The City of Santa Maria Utilities Department offers free water audits to City residents. A Water Conservation Specialist visits your home and evaluates your fixtures for opportunities to save water (and money) indoors and outdoors.

A water audit involves the following:

- Identifying and describing the types of plumbing in your home
- Identifying leaks indoors and outdoors
- Evaluating your monthly water consumption
- Obtaining information regarding maintenance of irrigation systems
- Information regarding various types of low flow devices available to help conserve water
- Information on rebates, incentive programs, and water conservation strategies for residents

The Utilities Department will also provide a water conservation kit which includes a low flow showerhead, bathroom faucet aerators, kitchen swivel, fill cycle diverter, leak detection tablets, and a flow meter bag with installation instructions. Supplies are available when a water audit is performed at your home.
